Enrollment Fee : Class 1 – 4 RMB15,000/ HK\$17,400
Class 5 Reservation Fee RMB15,000 / HK\$17,400 (Including rental charge of data logger, ECU)

Conditions of the Event :

1. Sporting & Technical Regulation will be released on 15th JUN 2023.
2. Technical Regulation of Asia Pacific Road Sport Challenge has released on 13 March 2023.
3. Technical Table will be published 14 days before the race event.
4. The enrollment fee of Class 1 – 5 has includes 2 days of testing and 2 Events (4 rounds) charges.
5. If the registration quota is full, any withdrawal will be replaced by the standby applications, according to their priority of their confirmed payment time and date.
6. Official Practice, Qualifying and Race are required to use the designated tires and petrol
7. The designated tires of Class 1 – 3 is PIRELLI and Class 5 tires is open but the standard size is 215.
8. HK GT and HK Touring Car Events, the racers must prepare their own AIM EVO data logger.
9. Asia Pacific Roadsport Challenge, the racers must use the data logger and ECU provided by the organizer.
10. The eligible cars of HK GT, GT4 is referring to SRO; in GT3 class, all cars must be in strict compliance with its most up-to-date FIA Homologation Form including its latest extension, as well as the official Balance of Performance (BoP) Chart, Cars older than the most recent version may be accepted providing that they are in conformity with the most recent homologation for that version. The decision to admit such a car will be at the discretion of the Organising Committee.
11. The eligible cars of HK Touring Car is reserved exclusively for cars having a TCR Technical Form issue by the WSC-TCR Technical Department.
